The Governing Board wishes to remove authorization for an employee to receive payment for unused vacation from Policy 6530.

Legislative Report

Mr. Wheeler reported the quarantining restrictions in classrooms and on school busses have changed. Only those in close proximity with an individual who tests positive for COVID-19 while not wearing a mask need to quarantine. HB123 regarding Suicide Prevention and School Safety Training has been signed into law and training will begin in schools in the future. Per Heather Wolfe, Superintendent, the School Safety Training Grant will be spent on PBIS. School districts will be getting more COVID Relief funding from the federal government, but ESC's do not qualify for the disbursement.
